Requirements for the AUTOMOBILE TRAVELER BADGE

There are currently only 6 REGULAR BBS&RDA Mainstream clubs. Attend 6 of these BBS&RDA clubs (regular or special dances) and 2 other dances to be determined (see BBSRDA website after June 1).

Only Mainstream Dance clubs are eligible for this badge. Totals subject to change on a yearly basis.

Requirements for the AMBASSADOR BADGE

Attend 6 more REGULAR BBS&RDA clubs again (regular or special dances). This includes Mainstream, Plus, Advanced, Challenge and Round dance clubs. There is no time limit.

If you only dance Mainstream you can visit REGULAR Mainstream clubs a second time for this badge. Totals subject to change on a yearly basis. The MACA dance counts also for this badge.

Requirements for the CENTURY BADGE

Attend 6 more BBS&RDA clubs again (regular or special dances). This includes Mainstream, Plus, Advanced, Challenge and Round dance clubs. There is no time limit.

If you only dance mainstream you can visit REGULAR Mainstream clubs a third time for this badge. Totals subject to change on a yearly basis. The MACA dance counts also for this badge.

There is no time limit for the Ambassador and Century badges. The recipients of these badges will be announced at the BBSRDA dances, but the badges will be presented to them at one of their home club events. Send or give the list to any BBS&RDA director or contact the Badge Director – see List of Directors on the BBS&RDA web site.

If you do not dance above the Mainstream level you can repeat a club a second time for the Ambassador badge and a third time for the Century badge.

Travel Badges

Border Boosters Square & Round Dance Association Free Travel Badges

Free Travel badges are available to those dancers who visit square or round dance clubs and the special BBS&RDA dances. The **Automobile Traveler's** badge is for visiting **REGULAR BBSRDA mainstream** dance clubs. The **Ambassador** and **Century** badges are for any **REGULAR BBS&RDA** club at any level.

A **special** dance sponsored by a club counts as a visit to that club.

Your **home** club does not count as a club visited. If you are a member of more than one club then declare one of the clubs as your home club. The others will count as visits.

There is a printable sheet on the BBS&RDA web site. You can always print this out and use it to collect signatures from clubs visited.

You are visiting clubs, not callers. The callers just sign the sheet for visits to clubs. Only visits to **REGULAR BBS&RDA** clubs are eligible for the Travel Badges.

Directors sign the sheet for the BBS&RDA dance requirements.

If you forget your sheet, ask the caller (or director) to sign and date any piece of paper. Attach this to your sheet with a note saying "see attached".

Photocopy your sheet as you progress in case of loss.

Automobile badge – 8 visits

Visit all **mainstream REGULAR** dance clubs, or their **club sponsored** events and one (1) BBS&RDA special dance. Currently that is 6 visits since we have 6 regular clubs that dance at the mainstream level. **There are 2 other dances that will be determined soon.**

Visiting a club taking part in some other organization's affair or celebration does **not** count as a visit for Travel Badge purposes.

The 8 visits (plus one BBS&RDA dance) for a total of 9 visits must be done in a 12 month period.

Please fill in the Date, Club and Place ahead of time so the caller just has to add his or her signature.

Ambassador badge – 6 more club visits for a total of 14 and one (1) more BBS&RDA special dance.

The MACA dance and regular round dance clubs are also eligible.

Century badge – 6 more club visits for a total of 20 and one (1) more BBS&RDA special dance.

All **REGULAR BBS&RDA** clubs (mainstream, plus, advanced, challenge and round dance) as well as **MACA** dances are eligible for the Ambassador and Century badges.

If you **do not round dance** or if you **do not dance above the mainstream level** then you can visit mainstream clubs a second time for the Ambassador badge and a third time for the Century badge.

There is no time limit for the Automobile and Century badges.

Please fill in the Date, Club and Place ahead of time so the caller just has to add his or her signature.

These rules are subject to change on a yearly basis. For more information contact the **badge director**.
