On July 1/10 Ontario implemented a tax called **Harmonization Tax**. This will cause the tax on your balance to increase from 10% to 13%. Consequently balances will increase per room per night as follows:
 Single occupancy \$3.24
 Double occupancy \$4.88
 Junior Suites \$5.24.

The staff for our second Summer Magic call levels from Basic to C3A. Together they have 250 years of experience entertaining square dancers all over the world. We are sure that you will enjoy them.

Computer Squares, Hardwood floor & Carpeted floors Bring leather sole shoes

Computer squares will be implemented in three rooms. They are the A-1, A-2 & C-1 halls. The session will start with an open tip, and for the balance of the session, computer squares will be used. The names will be projected on a screen enabling all dancers to see from a distance. The plus hall has a hardwood floor, that is where the round dancing will take place. The Mainstream A-1, A-2 & C-1 rooms

have a low pile carpet which we have tested with leather sole shoes and it works fine. Also, silicone will be available to spray on mats and you can wipe the bottom of your shoes on the mat. Leather seems to be the best option. The first year we tested many varieties of footwear but after all was said and done, it seemed that almost all footwear was satisfactory. The floor in the main-stream room will be lifted as it was sticky. The carpet was better.



Warm up Dance - Friday, 2:30 pm - 4:00 pm-

This year we are planning a warm up dance for those dancers who will arrive early Friday afternoon. If you have to wait until your room is ready, this will give you something to do.

Each year we will strive to make the weekend better and better.
